



CLEANING AND MAINTENANCE OF PROFESSIONAL VENETIAN PLASTER 2400

Anvil Professional Venetian Plaster 2400 is a modern modified acrylic finish that exhibits greater resistance to dirt pick up and airborne pollutants, the lime based plasters. With proper care and maintenance, this premium decorative artistic coating will deliver years of beauty and pride.

GENERAL CLEANING: Abrasive cleaners and vigorous scrubbing will damage the appearance. Therefore, make a soapy water mixture of mild dishwashing detergent, (two teaspoons per gallon of water); with a soft cloth gently wash the surface to remove airborne pollutants.

SPOT CLEANING: If organic substances have soiled the surface (food, soft drinks, hand oils or other common substances) spot cleaning may be needed. Spray a soapy water mixture on the soiled area and wipe with a soft cloth gently remove. Make your soapy water spray with a mild dish washing detergent liquid diluted 80% (1 to 5). Please note: always rinse the cleaning products off the wall with clean water and then blot dry with a clean towel.

MORE DIFFICULT SPOT CLEANING: Always start the cleaning process using the mildest method above first. If after repeated washing attempts with the soapy water spray method does not remove the substances, spray the damp area with a good, non-colored, general household spray cleaner and wipe again. Please note: always rinse the cleaning products off the wall with clean water and then blot dry with a clean towel. Do not use bleach or acid based cleaners for they will soften the coating and discoloration will occur and reapplication of the finish might be needed.

REPAIR: If minor damage from nicks and scratches have penetrated the finish; apply the original product into the scratched area to fill in the color. Use a small spackling knife and trowel into the finish to blend color and texture.
